Missional Giving Policy - St Peter's West Blatchington

Giving by the church should always be missional, or have a missional aspect to it.

Our giving should cover the spectrum of very local to national/ international good causes.

Giving should be to organisations that are charities under UK law or any equivalent local law and to similar non-profit making organisations.

Our support for charities should not just be financial, but also include giving of time, skills and material goods, where possible. Most importantly, we encourage the congregation to pray for any commended charities.

Charities are chosen by the congregation each year. We have a total of 7 and for every £1 donated by our Parishioners, we may match the same amount to send onto the Charity. This is ratified annually at the APCM.

The charity of the month is displayed at the back of Church as well as advertised in our Parish magazine Keynotes.

None of the above is intended to discourage individual church members from continuing to support causes to which they feel called.
